

The Fathering Project - Privacy Collection Statement

The Fathering Project believes privacy is an important right of individuals. The Fathering Project takes steps to protect your personal information from misuse and to use your information only in a manner consistent with our privacy policy and the Australian Privacy Principles.

Collection of your personal information

The personal information we collect from you when you sign up for membership with The Fathering Project via our website or The Fathering Project App may include your:

- name;
- email address;
- contact details;
- state and postcode;
- date of birth;
- child's first name, gender, and month of birth;
- partner's name and month of birth; and
- Working With Children card number and expiry (in the case of group leaders only).

Use of your personal information

The personal information we collect from you may be used to:

- keep you up to date with The Fathering Project, its weekly email tips, resources, and event information (if you select subscribe to these options);
- send you reminders of key dates for your family;
- tailor our communications to ensure they are as relevant as possible to you;
- facilitate the setting up of a Dads' Group;
- provide you with offers and marketing materials (if you select subscribe to this option); and
- any other purposes related to the above or otherwise necessary to give effect to the purposes listed above.

We will not use your personal information for any other purpose, and will not disclose your information to any third parties other than in accordance with the terms of our privacy policy or as otherwise authorised by law.

Disclosure of your personal information

The Fathering Project is the controller of the personal information which we collect from you. When you provide us with your personal information, no entities other than The Fathering Project will determine how that information will be used.

It may be necessary for us to disclose your personal information to our employees and third party service providers, such as those contractors that The Fathering Project engages to assist in providing services to

you, including website developers, contracted administrative service providers, program coordinating staff, and communications consultants.

We may also indirectly disclose some of your personal information to third parties overseas as we use various third party service providers which may utilise servers located overseas including, amongst others, iiNet and Ventra IP.

Consent

By providing your personal information to us and ticking the relevant box, you consent to the collection of that information for the purposes set out in this collection notice and our privacy policy. If you do not wish to provide your consent, please do not provide your personal information. In this event, you will not be able to subscribe to membership of The Fathering Project. If given, your consent operates until such time as you tell us that you wish to withdraw your consent. As such, you will continue to be a member, and we will continue to hold, use and disclose your personal information for the purposes set out in this collection notice and our privacy policy, until you unsubscribe.

If you wish to withdraw from membership of The Fathering Project entirely, you may do so by sending an email to 'admin@thefatheringproject.org' with the subject line 'Delete My Account'. You can withdraw your consent and unsubscribe from our email service at any time (whilst remaining a member of The Fathering Project). You can do this by clicking on the "Unsubscribe" link at the bottom of any of our emails to you or by accessing 'your profile' at <https://thefatheringproject.org/members/personal-details/> and unchecking the box labelled "I am interested in receiving weekly email tips from The Fathering Project".
