

# Registering for The Fathering Project In Schools

## Step 1

### Seek endorsement from your school

Registration to The Fathering Project In Schools must be endorsed by an authorised representative of the associated school. For dads and parents; it's a good idea to meet with the authorised representative of your school (typically the principal), explain the program and cost, and receive endorsement.

## Step 2

### Submit your group registration form

Fill out the school registration form at [www.thefatheringproject.org/in-schools/register-school/](http://www.thefatheringproject.org/in-schools/register-school/)  
After registration and endorsement are received by The Fathering Project, an annual service fee is invoiced to the associated school or organisation.

## Step 3

### Recruit dads and assign group leaders

Once registration is processed, you will be notified and dads can begin joining your school's Dads Group via the 'Join a Dads Group' page at [www.thefatheringproject.org/in-schools/join-a-group/](http://www.thefatheringproject.org/in-schools/join-a-group/)  
You can also select your group leaders, who will be given access to the team management tools within the members portal.

## Step 4

### Host a launch event

The Fathering Project In Schools initiative is officially activated in each school with a Dads Group launch event. This is the final step in setting up your Dads Group. Our team will work with your leaders to organise a group launch event, to which all the dads from your school will be invited and a presentation will be delivered about the Dads Group program, how it works, the benefits for members, and the resources and support available.
